MATH: SPATIAL RELATIONSHIPS (Point to a book, pencil and piece of paper on the table and give your child the directions. If your child follows the direction, put a check in the box.)

(Point to the star. Say:)	What shape is this?	<input type="checkbox"/> Star

SCIENCE: (Tell your child you are going to talk about soaking/floating and magnets. When your child answers the question, check your child's answer in the box.)

ALPHABET: (Point to the pictures below. Say the name of each animal one at a time, so your child can hear the beginning sound. Then point to the letters and say their names.)

(Point to the bird. Say:)	This is a bird. Bird starts with B. Point to the B.
(Point to the fish. Say:)	This is a fish. Fish starts with F. Point to the F.
(Point to the cat. Say:)	This is a cat. Cat starts with C. Point to the C.
(Point to the lion. Say:)	This is a lion. Lion starts with L. Point to the L.
(Point to the dog. Say:)	This is a dog. Dog starts with D. Point to the D.
